The Brady Center to Prevent Gun Violence filed its amicus brief on May 18, 2010. The caption on the brief indicates it was also filed on behalf of the International Brotherhood of Police Officers, Hispanic American Police Command Officers Association, National Black Police Association, National Network To End Domestic Violence, Montanans United to Stop Gun Violence and The Montana Human Rights Network. With the exception of the Brady Center, however, none of these entities has sought or received permission to appear as amicus curiae in this case. The caption on the brief also indicates that Gil N.

Peles, of Proskauer Rose LLP, is involved in this case as counsel for the Brady Center. But Mr. Peles has not filed a motion for leave to appear pro hac vice under Local Rule 83.3(e). Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the Court will consider the May 18, 2010, amicus brief as if filed only on behalf of the Brady Center. If the other entities identified above would like to appear as amicus curiae and join in the Brady Center's brief, they must file a motion for leave to do so. In view of Mr. Peles' apparent involvement as counsel for the Brady Center,

IT FURTHER ORDERED that, on or before May 25, 2010, Mr. Peles file a motion for leave to appear pro hac vice on behalf of the Brady Center in this litigation.
